Racing Rope of Hope

Please remember that on Saturday 19th September 2009 we will be making a Racing Rope of Hope at Phakisa in support of The Sunflower Fund – remembering those with leukemia and blood disorders.

Sunflower Fund Bandanas are available from Pick and Pay for R20 for National Bandana Day on the 14th October. This year schools, clubs and companies are getting together to buy Bandanas, tie them together and create a Rope of Hope. The Ropes of Hope will then go to Cedar Square for a celebration on the 10th October. All of the Ropes will then go to disadvantaged women who will sew the Bandanas together and make duvets for childrens' cancer wards. All in all – so many beneficiaries and such a small price to pay for the individual!

With the endorsement of the MRC and the Free State Marshalls, we are making a Racing Rope of Hope – our goal, to stretch it from the starting line to the back of the grid!

- After a day of exciting Regional Racing we will measure our Racing Rope of Hope and see if we have reached our goal!
